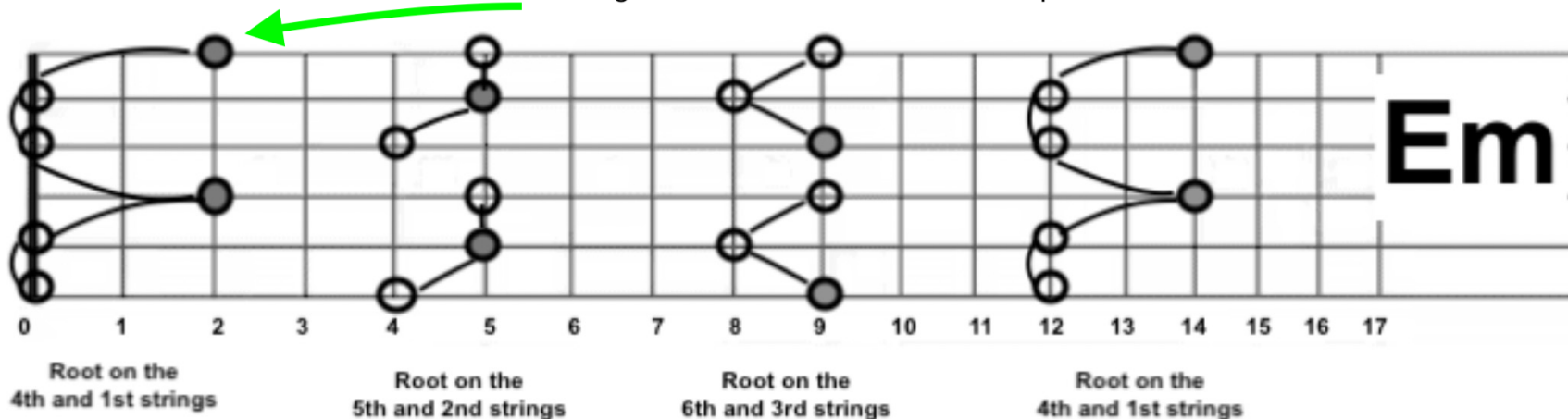


I'm including this chart just to show you one other way of visualizing the chord inversion with roots on the D strings: as more of a horseshoe shape



You can use these shapes or "chord note constellations" to easily find chord notes along a single string, e.g. on the 4th string: 2nd fret, 5th fret, 9th fret, 14th fret, 17th fret etc.
