

Sidebar: for the sake of accuracy, there's no such thing as a "half diminished triad," as a half-diminished chord requires four notes, so what you're seeing in these charts is just a regular diminished chord triad shape (the first three notes of the half-diminished chord that's in a given key). Don't worry about this detail - we're just using the chord shape to help visualize where the scale notes fall and will probably never use it for any other purpose in bluegrass and folk music. You can get through an entire career in bluegrass without ever encountering a diminished or half diminished chord in a song.
